The workshops also tie in with themes of *fitness, health, self-esteem,* and *healthy living* – which correspond with elements of the *Australian Curriculum: Health and Physical Education*.

You'll be surprised at what your students can accomplish in a 1-hour workshop! Arch encourages everyone to have a go; by the end of a workshop, every student – regardless of ability – will feel like they have achieved something.

The original founding member of WickidForce & UnitdStyles Hiphop Movement, Arch has been dancing professionally for over 10 years.

Specialising in Hip-hop / Breaking / Popping & Locking, he has performed in various arenas around the world, supporting such acts as The Black Eyed Peas, Guy Sebastian & Shannon Knoll, Joel Turner, TvRock & the Rogue Traders, Kurtis Blow, Kaylan-Disco Montago, Groove Terminator, Islanda, CDB & more. He has also appeared in several TV shows & TV commercials. His crew, WickidForce, are three times Australian National Breakdance Champions and have represented Australia in the World Breakdancing Title's *Battle of the Year* several times.
