Making The Most of Your Author Visit...

Having an author visit your school is a fantastic way to inspire your students while also giving them the opportunity to learn more about writing and publishing books. The following guidelines will help ensure the students gain the maximum benefit from the visit.

Author Talks - Duration: 50 - 60 minutes

Sue speaks about writing, ideas, the publishing process and answers questions. Talks can be supported by power point presentations if the equipment is available.

- Maximum of 100 students per session is ideal but can do more if venue permits and students aren't squashed in.
- Suitable for Year 1 Year 12
- · Teachers must be present during the talk

Before the visit

- Suitable for Year 2 to Year 12
- Students to have paper, pens and be seated at tables or desks.
- Teachers must be present
