

## Sue Lawson

Author, Teacher and Writing Instructor



Award-winning author Sue Lawson can't remember when she fell in love with books and stories, but she can say stories and books have always been part of her life. Bookshelves bulged in her family home, her grandfather and father told endless stories, some true, some not, but all embellished, and her grandmother was an English teacher with a passion for words.

Sue came to writing after careers in teaching and radio, where she worked as a presenter and producer, all the time continuing to dabble with writing. It wasn't until she confronted serious illness that she pursued her passion. Sue now writes books for children and young adults, does a little teaching and runs workshops for young people and adults. She also presents a weekly book review on Geelong's Bay FM.

Sue's books include Pan's Whisper, shortlisted for the 2012 Prime Minister's Literary award and winner of the Family Therapists Award.

Sue liaises with schools to ensure her talks and workshops are tailored to suit the student's needs.

#### Talks:

Sue's background in education and radio make for entertaining and educational sessions, while her warm personality helps to create an fun, safe and inspirational atmosphere for students of all abilities. During her talks, Sue explains the stories behind her books and encourages students to follow their dreams. Her passion and enthusiasm is infectious and her feedback encouraging.

### Workshops:

Sue's workshops are interactive and practical, suitable for primary and secondary students, teachers and adults. Sue leads students through exercises to help them develop their skills and provides positive and directive advice. Topics include generating ideas, planning, beginnings, characters, dialogue, editing and more.

Artist in residency: \$3000 + GST per week.





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
